Open to all quilters of all ages and skill levels!

Finished blocks are due February 23, 2019

QUILT BLOCK CONTEST RULES.....Theme: "Celebrations"

1. The un-quilted block must be 12 1/2 inches square (a 12 inch block with a 1/4 inch seam allowance on all sides.)
2. The block must be the work of the entrant. Only one entry per person will be accepted.
3. Block may be constructed using any method. Construction should be visible from the back.
4. The finished block must be clean and pressed.
5. The block must be labeled with name and address of entrant safety pinned to the block.
6. Each category will be judged on correct size, color coordination, design, workmanship, and adaptation of theme.
7. First, Second, and Third places will be awarded in each category (1st-\$25, 2nd-\$15, 3rd-\$10). Prizes will be awarded at 4:00 pm at the quilt show, March 16, 2019.
